

2023-2024 School Leadership Academy Program Syllabus

Program Description:

This is an executive training and coaching program in which the limited number of participants meet three times per month for ten months. The Academy will also include an in-person component consisting of a private School Leaders Forum in October in Denver, hosted by Our Lady of Lourdes. Each subsequent month will consist of four components:

Teaching Webinar [1 hour] Personal Consultation/One-on-one coaching [30 minutes] Summary teaching and Q&A Zoom Cohort Gathering [1 hour] Monthly Assignment

The Fall term will focus on re-establishing our understanding of the foundational principles of our calling as Catholic educators and leaders. Without grounding ourselves in the fundamentals, we will fall short in our ability to implement the particular demands of school leadership. Some practical application scenarios will come up, but that is much more prevalent in the next term.

The Spring term will move into the practical applications of the philosophy and mission of our calling. Both the teaching webinar and Zoom gatherings will expect all members of the cohort to bring to the discussion practical questions, scenarios, and each participant's own wisdom for the benefit of all.

Throughout the program, participants will be guided through exercises that will offer substantial practical tools for immediate use. We all know as educators that without being able to breathe forth what we learn, understanding and retention is marginal, at best. Therefore, the exercises/assignments are key to growing from the program in the way that it is intended. In order to receive certification of successful completion, all assignments need to be completed during the course of the Academy. Individual assignments may be adjusted for unique school situations. Our consultants will consider alternative assignments, but timely submissions and feedback are important to gain the full benefit of the Academy.
