Organization Description

The Institute for Catholic Liberal Education (ICLE) inspires and equips Catholic educators to renew today's Catholic schools by drawing on the Church's tradition of education, which frees teachers and students for the joyful pursuit of faith, wisdom, and virtue. The ICLE offers Catholic schools a concrete roadmap as well as inspiring instructional models as they prepare to bring the renewal of Catholic education to life. Position Description and Responsibilities

The Institute for Catholic Liberal Education seeks a master teacher to participate in ICLE's work of forming teachers in a Catholic understanding and practice of Catholic liberal arts education. The ICLE faculty is a tight-knit community of educators who work together to form Catholic school teachers across the country.

This position will require travel, averaging two trips per month, each lasting two to three days, to deliver on-site workshops, attend ICLE events, and provide ongoing consultation and webinars for schools. This new faculty member will be trained in ICLE's teacher formation curriculum and will be asked to draw from his or her own knowledge and experience to create new presentations and materials. The job will also include ICLE internal projects, as needed, such as curricular research and consulting.

The ideal candidate would be a faith-filled, dynamic Catholic educator with significant experience teaching in liberal arts schools and in Catholic education. Experience in instructional coaching or mentoring is a plus. We are looking for a disciple of Christ with a heart for this mission to help Catholic educators renew their vocations so they may renew their school communities.
